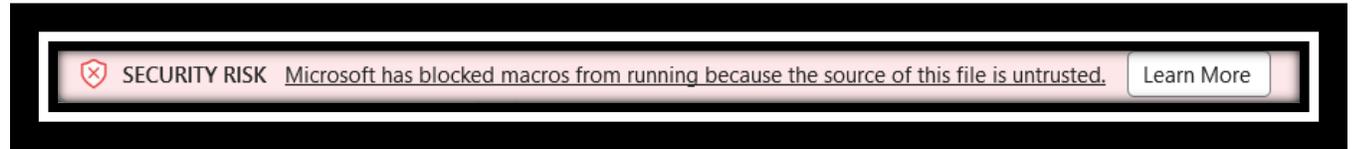


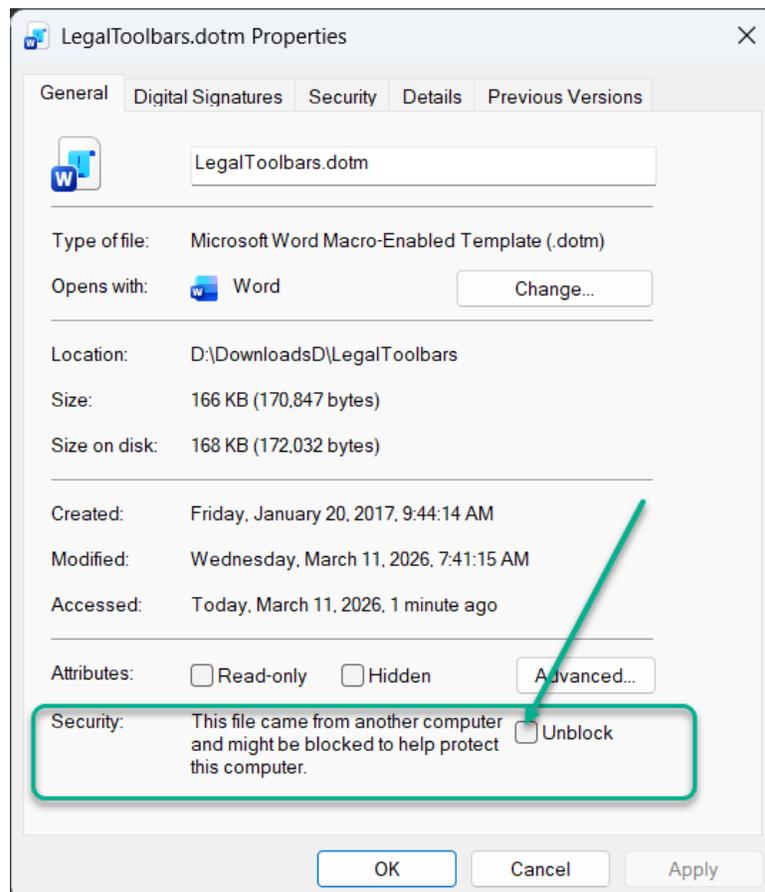
Dealing with Security Risk Warning

If you see the above, it means that the file originated off your computer and contains macros. It does not mean anything more, or less. If you trust those macros, you will want to remove the “Mark of the Web” file block in the file’s properties.

You can not do this from within Word. It must be done in the Operating System. In Windows, using Explorer, right-click on the File icon and choose Properties. You should see something like this:



Check the Unblock box and click on OK. Then you can use the file macros if allowed by your Trust Center settings.
